



Conditions of Participation

Please Read and Understand the Following: (If not adhered to, may result in dismissal from program)

- **Students must arrive on time.** Please do not be late, this will allow classes to begin as scheduled with all students present.
- **Payment is due on the first day of each session.** If paying weekly, payment is due on Monday. Arrangements can be made if necessary. Please contact the Director to make arrangements.
- **All Field trips are paid separately.** It is not required for all students to attend field trips, but definitely encouraged. Our field trips are planned based on learning expectations for the week and they are just plain fun.
- **Parents must sign the children in and out each day.** Students will need to sign in and out each day for insurance and attendance purposes.
- **Please leave all valuables at home.** OSA, Inc is not responsible for any valuables brought into the school. **CELL PHONES, GAME SYSTEMS, AND MP3 PLAYERS, etc ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE USED DURING ANY CLASS,** unless otherwise authorization has been given by the instructor or director of the school. Cell phones may only be used during designated times. If items are used during class time, without prior permission, they will be confiscated and returned to the parent only during sign out at the end of the day.
- **Absolutely NO stealing, fighting, or destruction of property.** If any student is found stealing, fighting, and/or damaging another student's items or any items/property of OSA, Inc. That student will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law and immediately dismissed from the program without a refund.
